- Please be patient. Our newest and youngest students are learning how to carry backpacks, unbuckle themselves, and close the doors. We will have MS helpers assist younger students.

## **Water bottles**

Please pack water bottles for your student. Label them with last names, it's amazing how many students carry the same bottle. Bottles should be small enough to fit in the water carriers on the sides of their chair bags. The bulkier the water bottle, the more difficult it is to carry. We have water filling stations in all our hallways and in the Readiness room.

## **One Call Now Alerts**

One Call Now is Lial's communication system to notify families if school is delayed or closed. Lial follows Anthony Wayne Schools for delays/closings due to weather. You will not see Lial's name on local channels or the radio if there is a delay or closing. Lial will notify families who are enrolled in our "One Call Now" response list if there is a delay or closing. We also use "One Call Now" for any emergent notifications we need to let families know.

### **School Pictures**

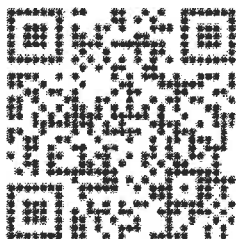

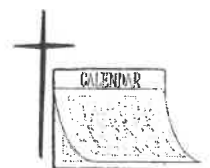

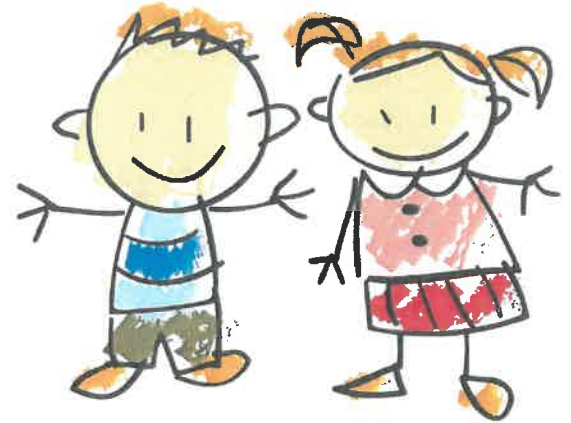
