MAP testing begins at Lial next Monday, September 11th. MAP testing is the standardized test used by the Toledo Diocese for students in K-8 in reading and math. MAP testing is considered a "snapshot" and one of many ways our teachers assess students' strengths and areas where they may need help. Students cannot "study" for these tests. Look to your weekly newsletters from the family room teachers to learn what days your student will take the tests. Be sure they are well rested, eat a good breakfast, and are on time for school. MAP results are shared during conferences.

### **Lial Fall Chess Club**

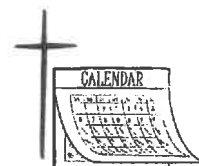
