The Intermediate Savio Club of Lial School would like to invite you to bring the joy of Christmas to a needy child this year by participating in **A Box of Joy**. This is an exciting program that demonstrates God's love through gift-filled shoeboxes. The boxes that are collected are then delivered worldwide to millions of children affected by war, poverty, disease, and disaster.

The National Collection Week is **November 4-12, 2023**. Below is information to help with the packing of the boxes.

1. We have shoeboxes here at school. Each box will come with a brochure that explains the program in detail. Students will be introduced to the Box of Joy program this week.
2. Choose either a girl or a boy in one of the following age groups:
Ages 2-4, ages 5-9, or ages 10-14
3. Fill your shoebox with small gifts. Here are some suggestions:
TOYS- small cars, balls, dolls, yo-yos, stuffed animals, a slinky, etc.
SCHOOL SUPPLIES- pencils/pencil sharpeners, crayons, colored pencils, markers, coloring books, etc.
HYGIENE ITEMS- toothbrush, toothpaste, bar soap, comb, brush, etc.
RELIGIOUS ITEMS- rosaries, tiny nativity figures, crosses
OTHER- hard candies, lollipops, mints, sunglasses, solar-powered flashlight, drawstring bag to carry items, etc.
4. Items that you would not include:
Used items
War-related items (toy guns, knives...)
Perishable food items (no chocolate)
Liquids (shampoo, lotion, bubbles...)
Medicines (cough drops, vitamins, ointments...)
Breakable items (mirror, snow globes...)
5. With the brochure is an envelope and you are asked to include a \$9.00 donation for shipping and support for missionaries working around the world. You may donate online as well. If you have more than one box, you may write one check to cover all the boxes. The envelopes should be given to Mrs. O'Donnell and **NOT** put in the actual boxes.
6. The boxes can begin to be collected at school on Monday, **November 6, 2023**. **All boxes need to be turned in to school by Thursday, November 9, 2023** by 4:00 p.m. Thank you for your participation in this project that will share and spread the Christmas message.
